





COVID Symptoms

Lateral Flow Tests that are used with school staff, and secondary school children, are not to be used on anyone that has symptoms, they are used to detect asymptomatic cases. If you are asked to pick your child up from school due to COVID symptoms, please note that you must also take siblings home until test results come back. Please read current LA guidance attached to this letter.


