English: In English this half term we will be investigating plastic in our oceans. We will be researching lots of facts about plastics and the consequences of it to our wild life. Discovery Friday will provide different opportunities to explore and practice our problem-solving skills.

During the summer term year 4 will complete the statutory times table test and this be a key focus this year.

History this half term investigates what happened when the Romans left and how life changed under the Anglo-Saxons.

Science is an exploration of states of matter as we learn about what a state of matter is and whether it can be changed. We will conduct experiments to prove, or disprove our theories.
