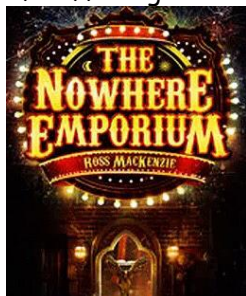


Thank you!
